Dear Parents and Carers,

The season of fun-filled festivities will soon be upon us and we are busy finalising a festive line-up for the FSA Christmas Fair. This year, **the fair will be held on Saturday 8 December**, and we will have firm favourites such as the chocolate tombola, presents for parents room and of course the raffle; and don't forget the chance to meet Santa himself!

We hope the fair will raise much needed funds for the school, so we will be holding a **non-uniform** day to help collect donations for the fair on **Friday 7 December 2018**. On 7 December children will be allowed to wear their own clothes (please note that they should still look reasonably smart, and wear sensible shoes), and in return, we would be grateful if you would donate some much-needed items in the containers that will be available in the playground that morning:

Foundation Stage and KS1 – a prize-worthy bottle (such as wine, bubble bath etc.)

KS2 – some chocolate or £1 cash

We would also appreciate it if you were able donate any of the following:

- **Unwanted, but prize-worthy, items, for example books or toiletries**

Prizes include vouchers for eating out, beauty and Amazon, as well as many more.

Finally, you should have received a parentmail requesting volunteers to help man stalls at the fair. We would like to thank those who have offered to help but we still need more people – the more people there are, the less everyone will have to do!
