The Early Years Foundation Stage Learning Journey

Key Worker Parent Sessions

All children in the Foundation Stage now have a 'Learning Journey'. This special book chronicles each step and achievement in your child's learning journey at school. However, a key aspect of the Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum is to involve parents in their child's learning, and we feel it is important to include the accomplishments that your child achieves at home. We do hope that you will want to be involved!

Every half term parents and children will be invited in to the Foundation Stage Unit to look at 'Learning Journeys'. Your child's key worker will be on hand during this time to discuss any issues you have. We would ask parents to note down anything special that has happened at home; for example, perhaps your child is learning to swim, can ride a bicycle without stabilisers or has been a kind brother/sister etc. Each child will have a special wallet where you can pop in a brief note, photograph or drawing chronicling the special achievement. Foundation Stage staff will then put these fantastic contributions into your child's 'Learning Journey' to build a clear picture of your child's achievements.

Your child's key worker is Mrs Bottrill and her key worker afternoon will take place on:

Tuesday 18th December from 2.30 - 2.50pm.

There will also be time to share a story book with your child in the classroom.
