### Music For Youth Prom: Important final details

We hope that you and your child are as excited as we are about the upcoming *Music for Youth* prom at the Royal Albert Hall! In this letter are details with regard to the rehearsal in Leicester next Thursday, 1<sup>st</sup> November (a reminder of details given in the initial letter) and for the concert day, Tuesday, 6<sup>th</sup> November. There is a lot of information, especially with regard to what the children will need to have with them on these days. A separate letter will be sent with a few more details for you as audience members. This will include details of the parents' coach.

**Thursday, 1<sup>st</sup> November:** A reminder about the rehearsal at the All Nations Church, Leicester: **2.30pm – 7.30pm**. We will travel by coach to the venue only (children accompanied by Miss Panter and myself). Children will need to be collected promptly from **All Nations Church, 10 Frog Island, Leicester, LE3 5AG at the finish time of 7.30pm**.

As this is obviously a long rehearsal, please send children to school with a packed tea – no items containing nuts, please - and an extra bottle of water (labelled with your child's name) that they can have during a break.

At this rehearsal, children will also be given their special concert t-shirt.

### Concert Day! Tuesday, 6<sup>th</sup> November:

**Please bring children to school for 7.30am**. I will let them in at the main (office) entrance. Our coach will be leaving promptly at 7.50am; as we will then be picking up children from another school and need to be at the concert venue by 12.30pm, we will not be able to wait for any children who arrive late. Children will be accompanied by Miss Panter, Mr Scranage, Miss Bennett and myself.


Please ensure that children 'travel light' and only bring the following, as we will have no space at the venue to store any large bags. Children's packed lunch and tea should be brought in disposable bags.

### Clothing

- **Children should wear:**
- **Black or dark grey on their bottom half. If girls wear a skirt, black tights must be worn.**
- **Black shoes (and black socks)**
- **Concert t-shirt**
- **Fleckney School jumper** (labelled with his/her name)
- **Warm coat** (labelled with his/her name)

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## Food

### Children will need:

- A **packed lunch** AND a **packed tea**, both in disposable bags and labelled with your child's name
- A **snack and extra drink** for after the concert (to have before the coach journey home)
- Enough water to keep them hydrated through a long and exciting day!  
Please note that **only bottles of water** (labelled with your child's name, please) **are allowed in the auditorium**. Children can keep these under their seats.
- Any medication they need to have with them (eg for asthma/allergies)

We will have our lunch upon arrival. We will then rehearse at the venue and will have a short break in the late afternoon, at which time we have arranged to visit the Natural History Museum (a short walk away). We will have our packed teas in the picnic area of the museum before returning to The Royal Albert Hall to get ready for the concert.

The concert will begin at 7pm. **Our estimated arrival time back in Fleckney is 12.30am on Wednesday, 7<sup>th</sup> November. We will keep you informed, via Parentmail text, of any delays and of our stimated time of arrival.**

**Children will need to be collected from the school promptly upon our return.**
