Summary of Results.

There were a total of 98 responses to the survey.

I have added my comments where necessary in italics.

My child feels happy and safe at this school	96%	1%	3%
My child makes good progress at this school	98%	1%	1%
My child is well looked after at this school	97%	2%	1%
My child is taught well at this school	98%	2%	0%

	<i>This is always a contentious issue. We try to balance the demands of government guidance against the needs of the children and your wishes as parents. It is always under review.</i>		
The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved	91%	6%	3%
The school deals effectively with bullying	39%	56%	5%
	<i>Thankfully incidents of bullying are relatively low. However the large 'don't know' category means we need to communicate our anti-bullying strategy and procedures with you much better.</i>		
The school is well led and managed	100%	0%	0%
The school responds well to any concerns I raise	79%	17%	4%
	<i>The 17% of 'don't knows comes from new parents or parents who have not raised any concerns.</i>		
I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress	88%	3%	9%
	<i>This is something we are always trying to improve. We introduced the informal drop-in parents evening, which the majority parents prefer, however this very much an issue of personal preference.</i>
