Dear Parents,

Please find your child's SAT results for this year. Please note the first page refers to the Teacher's Assessment of your child's progress. The second page refers to the scores that your child received in their tests.

Please bear in mind that the tests use standardised scores to judge whether a child meets or does not meet the expected standard. What is perceived as the expected standard is now much higher than under the old curriculum. The expected standard has also risen again since last year.

A score of 100 or more therefore means a child has achieved or exceeded the expected standard. A score of 99 or below means that the child has not achieved the expected standard. This might mean that a child scoring 99 or somewhere in the high nineties is perceived as not meeting the standard, even though they may only have missed out by one mark. This does not mean that the child has not made great progress in his or her learning.

The children have worked extremely hard in preparation for their tests and they should be very proud of their achievements. We have been delighted by all of the children's progress this year. However, please look at the test results together with the comments in the report. The report will give a much more accurate picture of the progress made by each individual child.
