Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of your child's education at Fleckney Church of England Primary School, we promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education programme. PSHE supports children to develop the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills they need to live safe, healthy and productive lives and to achieve their full potential.

We are writing to inform you that during the summer term, your child's class will be taking part in lessons focusing on **relationships education**. Relationships education is taught throughout the school in every year group and is carefully monitored and reviewed annually by both staff and the governing body.

As a school, we teach the statutory science and relationships education content as set out in the National Curriculum and published by the Department for Education (DfE). Beyond this statutory content, the only additional information taught is delivered to **Year 6 pupils only**. This approach aligns with current government guidance, which advises that such content is not introduced before Year 5.

In Year 6, we use a resource titled ***All About Us: Living and Growing – Alternative***, developed by Channel 4 Learning in collaboration with the Manchester Healthy Schools programme. This resource was created to support schools in delivering this sensitive content in an age-appropriate and considered manner.

As part of this programme, Year 6 pupils will view two short programmes:

- **Programme 7: How Babies Are Made**
- **Programme 8: How Babies Are Born**

Parents and carers have the right to request that their child is withdrawn from watching these programmes. Any such request must be made **in writing to the Headteacher by Friday 8th May 2026**.

Looking ahead, the next academic year will include a review of our current PSHE planning and resources, including those used for relationships and sex education. We will ensure that parents and carers are informed of any future changes that may arise as a result of this review.
